P&C Meeting 7pm tonight in the Staffroom. All welcome.

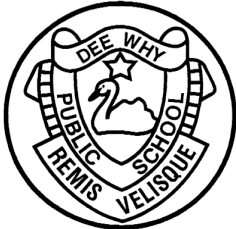
NO Coffee Club this Friday (last day of term) Enjoy the vacation!

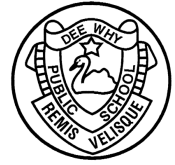

Core Rules in NSW Government School
