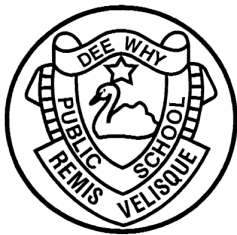
School Library

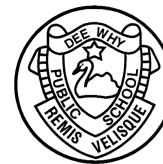

Core Rules in NSW Government School
